

## EYE EXAMS ENHANCED with Addition of New Retinal Camera

Greenville Eyecare is proud to announce the addition of the Topcon TRC-NW8 retinal camera to our practice. The TRC-NW8 comes with a Nikon D-90, 12 megapixel digital camera, enabling the doctors to zoom in on the finest detail to capture high resolution images. Nine fixation targets enable us to shoot nine images which can be collected to create a complete overview. The camera can even shoot 3D pictures!

Additionally, this camera allows us to use different filters that can pinpoint small details that are difficult if not impossible to see through a microscope. These filters will allow us to detect and monitor retinal disease more easily and improve the quality of care that we provide. This is vital in the treatment of diseases such as macular degeneration, glaucoma, diabetic retinopathy, and hypertensive retinopathy. The camera also features a low flash intensity that will improve patient comfort. The doctors are very excited about this technology and look forward to showing you how it works at your next eye exam!
